This \$25 "reservation deposit" will appear as a credit on Competition Balance Statements in the spring, for dancers making the Team; will be applied to November tuition for dancers who do not.

Eligibility Requirements

IMPORTANT CLASS LEVEL NOTE:

Candidates who do NOT make the Ensemble Team, or who choose to NOT audition, must transfer from Team classes into Exploration Level classes, effective October 24.



What We Need to See In Audition

We need to see **POSITIVE ENERGY, LOVE FOR WHAT YOU'RE DOING** and a **DESIRE TO IMPROVE**. **EXPRESS YOURSELF**: you must be able to COMMUNICATE – through EXPRESSIVE DANCING -- and <u>also VERBALLY & SOCIALLY</u>, with your instructors and with your fellow dancers. Other essentials: a RELENTLESS SMILE; ENDLESS ENERGY/STAMINA; an APPRECIATION FOR TEAM CONCEPT (enthusiasm, <u>kindness</u>, and support for ALL other dancers); the courage to REALLY TRY YOUR HARDEST and KEEP YOUR CHIN UP, <u>EVEN WHEN STRUGGLING</u>; plus TECHNICAL ABILITY; the ability to COUNT and to FEEL music; PRECISION/ATTENTION TO DETAIL; and (huge!) the ability to CONCENTRATE.

Team Classes Continue on Fall Schedule

These classes are a significant extension of the audition process – we will continue to evaluate all candidates and consult with all Team teachers and choreographers before making our final decisions.

Audition Decisions

FRIDAY, OCTOBER 21

Team Decisions will be issued to all candidates at <u>the start</u> of regularlyscheduled Team Contemporary Classes on Friday. OUR TEAM DECISIONS ARE WHAT WE BELIEVE BEST FOR THE TEAM and ARE NOT SUBJECT TO DEBATE. Ensemble Dance Team is first and foremost about THE TEAM CONCEPT: **all dancers must be able to work/fit within the groups/dances that we hope to create for THIS season**!

First Team Rehearsal

SATURDAY, OCTOBER 22

12:30-5:00PM

Every dancer who successfully auditions for the Ensemble Dance Team must then be prepared to FURTHER AUDITION FOR <u>SPECIFIC GROUP</u> <u>PLACEMENTS</u> beginning at this first Team Rehearsal of the new season.

Team Classes, Choreography, Rehearsals

DETAILED CLASS/REHEARSAL CALENDARS are planned and distributed generally in TWO-MONTH DURATIONS. Below is an outline of class & choreography/rehearsal DAYS, **NOVEMBER THRU MID-APRIL**. <u>TIMES WILL VARY</u>, depending on each dancer's group placements.

Five Competition Dances Included for All

All November-March choreography from TEAM CLASSES & REHEARSALS will be entered into competition in SPRING 2016. Each Team Dancers' monthly tuition installments include Choreography & Rehearsal for **FIVE** Team Dances: 1) group **JAZZ**; 2) group **TAP**; 3) group **LYRICAL**; 4) group **CONTEMPORARY**; 5) full-team long-form **PRODUCTION**.

Additional Dances (Optional and/or Selective)

Additional dances may include **DUO/TRIOS** (one or two) and "selectiveby-audition" pieces with **guest choreographers** in **FUSION**, **MODERN** and **HIP-HOP**. The possible addition of optional **SOLOS** will be discussed at the Team Parent Meeting on October 11.

Team Events, Workshops, Competitions

Team dancers will participate in one CELTICS PRE-GAME PERFORMANCE, one mandatory WINTER TRAVEL WORKSHOP; five SPRING REGIONAL COMPETITIONS; one SPRING DANCE CONCERT in MAY; and all DANCE CAROUSEL BIG SHOWS in JUNE. OPTIONAL FALL TRAVEL WORKSHOPS are offered (as well as one in APRIL). Several SOCIAL TEAM EVENTS are also planned. See "TEAM EVENTS SCHEDULE" PAGE for details. All Team Events are strictly mandatory (unless otherwise specifically indicated). ANY DANCER UNABLE TO PARTICIPATE IN ANY MANDATORY TEAM EVENT MUST NOT AUDITION FOR ENSEMBLE.

Attendance

The working rule is **ZERO ABSENCES**. In case of schedule conflicts, we often expect the dancers to sacrifice for Ensemble: **that is part of the COMMITMENT TO THE TEAM**. Any member with multiple absences – or ONE mandatory Team Event absence – may be asked to withdraw, without refund. <u>CLEAR COMMUNICAITON OF CONFLICTS OR ILLNESS IS ESSENTIAL</u> AND WILL BE STRESSED TO ALL DANCERS.

Public School Vacations

Important rehearsals will be scheduled over DECEMBER and FEBRUARY VACATIONS, after reviewing all submitted family vacation plans; but there are NO REHEARSALS over APRIL VACATION. <u>Very Important</u>: at the end February Vacation Week, **all dancers must be back by** <u>FOR DRESS</u> <u>REHEARSALS ON SATURDAY & SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 25/26</u>.

Behavior

ENSEMBLE represents the pinnacle of Dance Carousel to this and other communities. WE EXPECT EXCELLENT BEHAVIOR AT ALL TIMES, in and out of the studio. Team dancers must be able to handle themselves maturely in traveling situations. Team dancers must be strongly supportive and AMICABLE TOWARDS ALL PEERS; disparaging attitude or behavior towards any fellow dancer or faculty member is grounds for immediate dismissal. We expect Team dancers to behave respectfully towards their parents as well - in the studio, on the road, and at home. AND, CRITICALLY: TEAM DANCERS <u>MUST</u> WORK HARD TO KEEP UP SCHOOL GRADES AT ALL TIMES.



Parental Involvement

Every Regional trip requires PARENT DRIVERS (student-dancers driving to competitions is NOT allowed). Team Parents support each other in other ways as well, including carpooling to rehearsals, hair-styling, makeup, and backstage costume preparation. We are, first and foremost, a **TEAM:** Together Everyone Achieves More. Corny, but true.

Parental Support
